


Summermusic Lundsberg



Description

The chamber music week Summermusic Lundsberg started in 2019 and takes place every year in the beginning of July presenting a variety of music styles to a varied audience. The next edition takes place 6-13 July 2024. Its focus is on the, for a Swedish school, unique organ as well as on young professional musicians from Sweden and abroad. The concerts are presented live and livestream. An Art and applied arts and arts exhibition and a café hosting entertainment, Summer by the Stream, are other activities during the festival.

It takes place every year in July, when many tourists visit. Our vision is that the festival should remain a sustainable long term event.
